

Information about Your Stay

Lodging: Fischer Hall

Fischer Hall is located at 600 East Harrison Avenue.

Rooms are arranged in suites with a bathroom joining two rooms. Bathroom doors do not lock. Guests should work out a system of knocking with their suite mates. Most rooms contain two single beds, two desks, two dressers, closet space, and a window.

A laundry room is located on the lower level. A television, recreational equipment, and snack machines are located on the lower level. All floors have a lounge on each wing. Access to living areas on each floor is computer-controlled; accessibility is only through use of a keycard issued at check-in. Fischer has full elevator service.

Rooms are available on first come, first reserved. Contact ticket services for a list of local hotels (please note hotels are not within walking distance of Wheaton).

Arrival

Wheaton's policy states that their lodging building will be closed promptly at 10:00 p.m. Conference attendees may check in during published hours only. **Please do your best to arrive at Fischer Hall before 10:00 p.m.**

Conference attendees unable to register or check-in before 10:00 p.m. should plan to stay in a hotel and register the following day.

The price of linens are \$13/per attendee. Bundle includes the following: 1 regular sheet, 1 fitted sheet, 1 pillow/pillowcase, 2 face towels, 2 bath towels, 1 wash cloth, and 1 blanket. There is no maid service.

Check-In

Wheaton College **cannot accommodate individual early check-ins**. If you need accommodations before Wednesday night, please contact the Conference Services office in advance. Wheaton partners with several hotels in the area and can make those arrangements for your conference.

Room keys or keycards are issued to participants according to the number of beds in the room. When two groups are in residence in the same hall, keycards will be programmed to admit guests only onto those floors occupied by their group.

Internet Access

The internet can be accessed through in-room computer ports and wireless access and in the computer labs located in the residence halls.

Parking

Parking is free of charge to conference guests; permits are issued at check-in and are for designated lots. Permits are not required for commuters parking during daytime hours. Commuters may park at Fisher Hall, Traber Hall, or in the Jenks, Edman Chapel, or Billy Graham Center lots. Vehicles parking overnight must be parked in the designated lot. Wheaton College Public Safety will issue tickets for vehicles parked improperly, and will be billed to the conference if not paid.

Check-Out

Attendees are asked to deposit their soiled linens in the bin in the lobby prior to check-out. All keys, keycards , and KeyMates™ must be returned at check-out. Charges will be assessed for all missing keys, keycards, and KeyMates™ and linens not returned. Late check-outs cannot be accommodated.
