## **Minutes of 2022 Annual Meeting**

1. The APM meeting was held jointly over Zoom and in-person at St. Mary's College. Paul Lewis, APM President, 7:12pm June 16, 2022 called the meeting to order and opened with prayer. Paul informed everyone that the plenary presentations had been recorded, but the parallel session were not recorded (in answer to several questions he received during the event).
2. Minutes for the 2021 meeting were submitted by David Fenrick, Secretary-Treasurer, presented by Shawn Behan, Dir. of Membership and Member relations, and approved.
3. The Secretary- Treasurer's financial report was submitted by David Fenrick, Secretary-Treasurer, presented by Shawn Behan, Dir. of Membership and Member relations, and approved.

Nominations closed, seconded. Slate of officers elected, agreed that email election of the open positions will take place once we have people to fill those positions.

5. Robert Danielson provided an update on the online publication of APM proceedings. There have been 22,356 downloads since the partnership with First Fruits began, with 7,266 coming in the past year. The volume of the 2018 proceedings have been posted. The volume of the 2019 proceedings will be posted soon.

8. Paul Lewis thanked the Executive Committee and Advisory Board for their help in this year's event and welcomed the new APM President, Jay Moon.
9. Jay Moon thanked Paul Lewis for his work and introduced the topic for 2023 – "The Teaching and Practice of Intercultural Discipleship and Evangelism"
